

Text-Media / CTA

User experience:

As a user I would like to be guided to the relevant information by a prominent button.

Editor experience:

As an editor I would like to provide a prominent button within the content to guide the user to the targeted page.

There could be several Call-To-Actions (CTA) on a content page that offer interaction points for the user. Within the C10_Text-Media module we have

- a. links within a text
- b. a linklist
- c. CTA button

Links within the flowing text are used for cross links in the context of the content (multiple links):

We are systematically developing our **operating businesses** and strengthening them in a targeted way. The focus here is on the competitiveness of the individual business and the balance within our portfolio.


A linkl ist gives the possibility to offer a list of links (multiple links):

- **→** Policy Statement
- **⊥** UK Slavery Act Statement
- > Supplier Code of Conduct
- > Conflict minerals




In the use case, that the editor likes to provide a prominent call-to-action in the format of a button it is possible to change the layout of the link list, but just ONE link is possible then:

- Open the dropdown to select the CTA button instead of a linklist




- Choose the link type behind the CTA button: internal, external or a download

Independent from the link type, the design will be a button:



This could be helpful if you like to invite the user to a specific interaction to generate a kind of lead, for example to "Apply for a job" or "Register to this event".
